BONAVENTURE BOULEVARD LANE CLOSURES

APRIL 7-28, 2014

BETWEEN THREE VILLAGE ROAD AND INDIAN TRACE

Lane closures and traffic delays should be anticipated on Bonaventure Boulevard from Three Village Road to Indian Trace beginning April 7, 2014 through April 28, 2014.

It is recommended to use an alternate route through Town Center Boulevard.

The City of Weston has begun construction on the Weston Drainage Improvement Project in specific areas of the City. The project targets areas in Weston that are in need of drainage improvements, which will reduce the ponding of rain water run-off along roadways. Additionally, culvert pipes connecting lakes together under specific roadway locations will be installed or upgraded to a larger size thereby improving the entire storm water management system for the City.

The Project includes the construction of culverts, drainage structures, pipes, asphalt pavement restoration, roadside swales, lake/canal slopes, and landscape. An informational project open house was held on February 26th after noticing all impacted addresses.


In this project location a 72" drainage culvert will be installed to connect the lakes on either side of Bonaventure Boulevard as marked on the map below.

Overall project locations include portions of Lakeview Drive, Blatt Boulevard, Redwood Way, SW 5th Way, Ranch Road, and Bonaventure Boulevard.




Weston Drainage Improvement Project Bonaventure Blvd Culvert (#141A)
