The festivities begin on Saturday, July 4th at 7 a.m. with the **City of Weston Hometown 4th of July 5K Run/Walk**, presented in collaboration with Broward Health Weston. The race begins and ends at Weston Regional Park, 20200 Saddle Club Road. Online registration is now open at www.splitsecondtiming.com. Early registration is \$15 per person through June 15th; or \$20 through July 3rd (online registration will close at 7 a.m. on July 3rd.) Race day registration is \$25 per person and will begin onsite at 5:30 a.m. This family friendly race is a timed event and awards are presented for various categories and age groups.

The **City of Weston 4th of July Hometown Parade** steps off at 10:30 a.m. to follow its traditional route through Weston Town Center. This year's theme is *Celebrating Our Grand Old Flag*. Applications are now being accepted from bands, groups, organizations and businesses interested in participating in the parade.
