UPDATE

NAEGLERIA FOWLERI INFECTION NOT LOCATED IN CITY OF WESTON

Weston, FL – August 12, 2016, 5:15 p.m. –

After further consultation with the Florida Department of Health, City officials have been advised that the unfortunate contraction of *Naegleria fowleri* did **NOT** take place within the City of Weston.

The Health Department advised they believe that the individual contracted the infection after swimming in unsanitary water on a single private property, not accessible by the public. Health officials continue to investigate the location and have notified all persons with risk of exposure. No additional cases have been identified.
